Having been Head of the River in the men's and women's Lent and May bumps in the recent past, Emmanuel Boat Club is looking for someone with the experience to modernise the club in order to build on our consistently strong results and regain the top position on the Cam.

Rowing is a popular sport at Emmanuel, with around 80 participants throughout the year; over two-thirds of each year's new intake decide to take up rowing, and a significant part of the role is to provide coaching for crews of all levels from beginner to first-boat standard.

Emmanuel has one of the most up to date boathouses on the Cam, housing weight training and ergo facilities, along with a modern fleet and dedicated workshop.

Candidates should be able to work effectively with highly motivated young people, liaising closely with the student Captains along with current EBC coaches (mostly old members). Candidates would be expected to have the skills necessary to maintain our boats and equipment and will be expected to demonstrate their coaching ability. A formal coaching qualification is desirable but not necessary.
