Since its existence, members of our club have successfully rowed at many Olympic Games and World Rowing Championships as well as at various international and domestic rowing events. In 2004, one of our rowers participated at the Athens Olympic Games in the Quadruple Sculls event (8th ranked), our elite coxless pair won the silver medal at the Student World Championships in France and our club won the Swiss National Championships in the competitions of the eight and the coxless pair as well as the Yole de Mer in the elite class and, furthermore, the eight competition in a junior class, respectively.

For the near future, our main intentions are directed to keep and ensure the potential of our rowing team, particularly to enlarge and strengthen our junior squad with new talented rowers. Therefore, we are looking for a personality (man or woman) who is interested to work as **full-time Headcoach** in our rowing club. We expect for this position the following qualifications:

- experience in coaching of rowers and crews of different levels (international and national) and ages (junior to elite);
- ability to organise, plan and control the training of rowers and crews of different age and strength;
- experience in identification and instruction of rowing beginners;
- team-player with good communication skills;
- used to work independently and to lead a group of individuals of different ages and backgrounds;
- ability to execute administrative work;
- PC-knowledge;
- Good knowledge of the German language desired.
